THE SCHOOL RULES

PREAMBLE

These rules are to form the basis for all behaviours of pupils whilst enrolled in The Pittwater House Schools. These are to be read in conjunction with the Core Values. Interpretation of these rules is expressly within the responsibilities of the Principal or his delegate (Heads of School).

BEHAVIOUR AND RESPECT

- Behaviour of pupils will be appropriate to their maturity and reflect the Core Values at all times when at School and on School organised activities
 - No member of the School tolerates bullying or harassment
 - All pupils will show courtesy and respect towards their teachers, other members of staff, visitors to the School and the general public
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PURSUIT OF PERSONAL ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- Pupils are expected to work diligently at all times
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DRESS AND APPEARANCE

- All pupils will wear the uniform appropriate to the season and activity with pride. School uniform is prescribed separately and regularly reviewed by the Pupil Advisory Committee. Items shall be named
 - All pupils will wear their hair to an acceptable standard (as prescribed separately for boys and girls), remaining well groomed when in uniform and without unnatural tints.
 - The School does not approve of any jewellery or other non-uniform adornments being worn by any pupils of any age, especially those that may pose a health and safety risk. Girls only may wear a pair of plain silver or gold studs in the lower parts of the earlobe.
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THE SCHOOL RULES

PUNCTUALITY

- All pupils will be punctual on all school days and for all lessons and activities
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ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, SMOKING, ALCOHOL AND CHEWING GUM

- Pupils will not be involved in the use, consumption or supply of drugs, alcohol, tobacco or associated paraphernalia. The School has a zero tolerance to illegal drugs
 - The chewing of gum on campus and when wearing the School Uniform is prohibited
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FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT USAGE

- All pupils will respect school facilities and equipment including: classrooms, ICT, personal lockers, locked or 'out-of-bounds' areas, bathrooms, sporting and communal areas.
 - Pupil use of personal communication devices in the appropriate circumstances will be encouraged and strictly monitored by teaching staff
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TRADITION AND COMMUNITY

- All pupils will be supportive of the ethos of their school and demonstrate school pride and a positive school spirit through their involvement
 - All pupils will attend chapel, assembly and school events. Attendance at such activities is compulsory
 - The health and safety of every member of the School, visitors to campus and the wider public is everyone's responsibility
 - All pupils will use the most appropriate modes of transport for travel to and from school and maintain the highest standards of dress and behaviour whilst travelling.
