NO HIDDEN COSTS

Unlike many other schools, Pittwater House Tuition fees cover the educational program, including pastoral care, extension work, remedial and gifted programmes.

Our fees also include:

- Annual trip to Abercrombie House as part of our Country Life Scheme
- Participation in our Horizons program, which identifies and supports pupils requiring specific learning support, or gifted and talented/enrichment opportunities.
- MyHouse – our e-learning platform and all associated technological resources including laptops and iTouches.

Our fees do not include:

- School Books
- Uniform
- NSW Government High School Certificate charge – Form 12

All additional costs are charged on a “user pays” system, so you only pay for those services in which you elect to participate.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE EASY-FEE PLAN

1. No discount is offered for early payment.
2. All fees are to be paid by the 27th January 2010 (day 1 of Term 1). Where a pupil commences after 27th January 2010 the pro-rata balance of the full-years tuition is due on the day of commencement.
3. Fees can be paid by credit card (Mastercard, Visa, American Express or Diners Card). Bank charges made by your bank on fund transfers will be debited to your School Account.
4. Failure to pay an account by the date it is due may result in the Pupil being denied access to school services and may prejudice the pupils visa status.
5. Payment received after the due date will be subject to an automatic administration fee of \$100 or % per week (which ever is the higher amount) irrespective of the account balance.
6. Pupil Services Fee includes library, computing, email access, excursions and 24 hour worldwide accident insurance.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

A number of goods and services provided by the School attract the Goods and Services Tax (GST). GST will be added, where applicable, to pupil accounts and all fee paying parents will accept liability to pay these amounts by the due date.
