UNIFORM INFORMATION FOR SCHOOL STAFF, PARENTS AND CADETS



Every cadet should be wearing a uniform like this on a Cadet Wednesday!

Hat – slouch hat with red/white/blue band and gold badge,

- * chin strap under chin to hold hat when worn
- * this hat must be worn *to and from* school and is removed only when in a vehicle or inside a building

Shirt – sleeves down (not rolled up) it should have been lightly ironed and not full of creases.

- * Note it also should have a blue “Cadet” badge on the left sleeve.
- * Pockets should be buttoned closed

Trousers – properly done up and not worn too low, there are belt loops for those whose trousers are too big.

- * They should also be lightly ironed.
- * Side pockets should be buttoned closed.

* The bottom of each leg should be ‘bloused’ or ‘hemmed’ over the boot with an elastic garter firmly holding at the fold of the hemline so that the trousers are closed over the top portion of the upper boot

Boots – black boots are to be worn with this uniform *not shoes*.

- * Black boots must be polished to a high standard and all laces completely done up and hidden under the ‘blouse’ of the trouser leg.
- * Some older cadets still have the brown boots which they may continue to wear for the time being.



“Polyesters” is a separate more formal uniform for parades and public events [khaki shirt and trousers]
