#### TUITION FEES

- All fees and charges are payable in Australian Dollars (AU\$)
- International Tuition fees are billed yearly in advance and it is a condition of enrolment that international fees are payable on the first day of the first term.
- No discount is applied for early payment
- The full-year's fees are to be paid on 27 January 2009 (Day 1 of Term 1). Where a student commences in the School after 27 January 2009 the pro-rata balance of the full-year's tuition is due on the day of commencement.
- Charges for additional services including music tuition, textbooks, stationery ("incidental charges") are billed monthly.
- Fees can be paid by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express or Diners Card). Bank charges made by your bank on funds transfers will be debited to your School account.
- Failure to pay an account by the date it is due may result in the student being denied access to School services and may prejudice the student's Visa status. Payment received after the due date will be subject to an automatic debt administration fee of \$100 or 5% per week (whichever is the higher amount) irrespective of the account balance.

**SCHOOL UNIFORM VOUCHER** includes the summer and winter school uniforms, the complete sports uniform (including tracksuit and swimming costume) and School bags. A voucher will be provided on arrival to be used as a record for the issue of these items. School uniforms may be acquired over two different seasons from the Uniform Shop on campus.

**STUDENT SERVICES FEE** includes library, computing, email access, excursions and 24 hour worldwide accident insurance.
