Congratulations to our Class of 2013 on their success. We were pleased to be named in the Sydney Morning Herald's merit list for top performing schools in Mathematics and English.

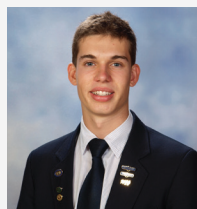
Highlights include Max Irish being listed in the Top All Rounders list and a large number of students noted as Distinguished Achievers in their given subjects:

- 80% Bands 5 & 6 achieved for all Legal Studies students

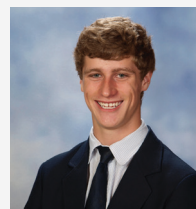

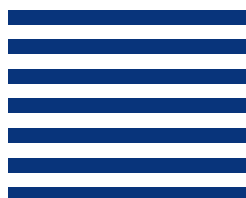

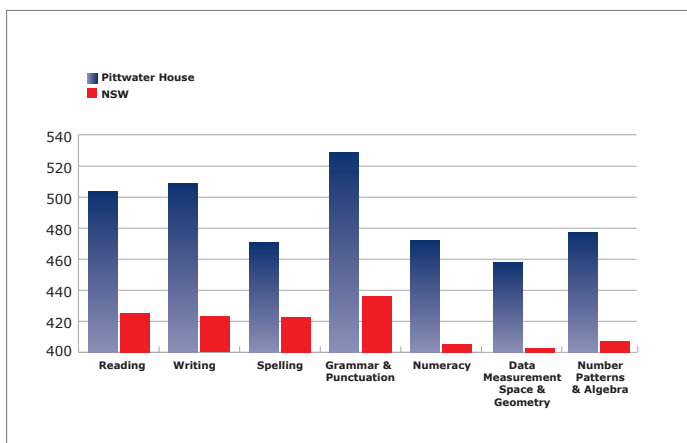
NAPLAN 2013

Pittwater House students achieved great results in the nationwide NAPLAN test in 2013. The results are significantly above the State average (mean) and demonstrate the hard work by both students and teachers.

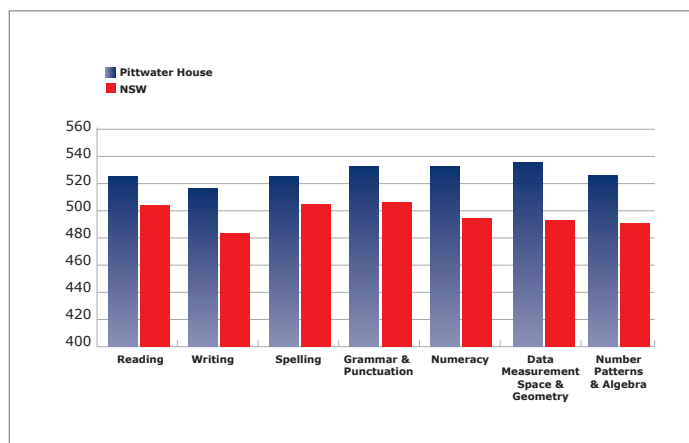
The NAPLAN tests are undertaken every year and students are tested on reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation, numeracy, data measurement, space and geometry, and number patterns and algebra. The graphs below show the mean or average performance of the students at Pittwater House School vs. the State results (NSW).

The Year 3 students at Pittwater House did particularly well with exceptionally good results across all areas of assessment.

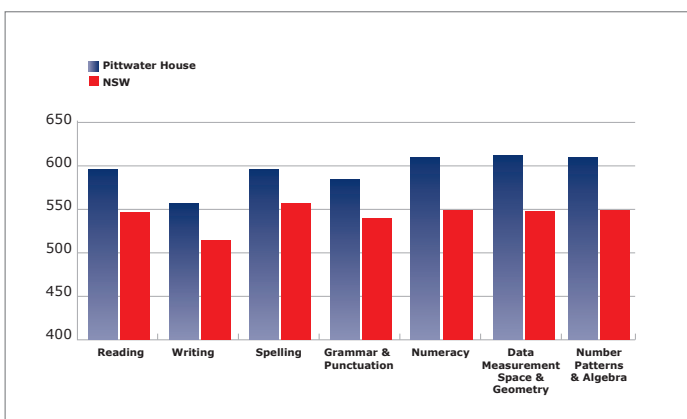
Year 3 Students
Mean of Pittwater House vs. NSW



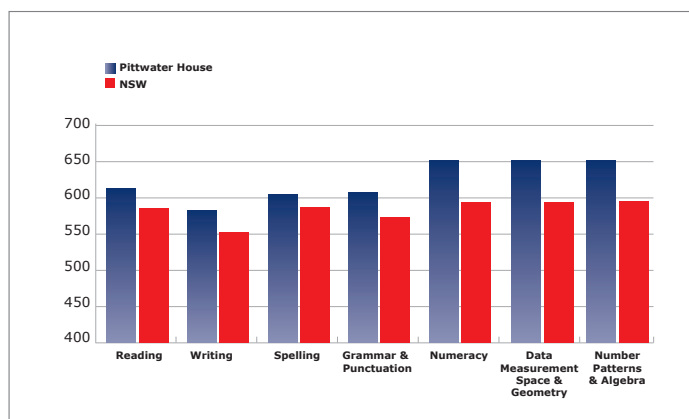
Year 5 Students
