












JUNIOR SCHOOL LIBRARY OVERVIEW

Welcome to the junior school library! Please see below, some of the borrowing rules and expectations we have to ensure the smooth and equitable running of the library.

-  Each junior class visits the library every week.
-  **ECC-Year 2:** 1 book; **Year 3- Year 12:** 2 books.
-  **Loan Length:** Picture books – one week
Chapter books - two weeks
-  Library bags are compulsory for ECC-year 6.
-  Books are expected to be returned each library lesson.
-  Chapter books may be renewed at the discretion of library staff and if there are no reserves on the items.
-  Borrowing from the junior school library ceases over the holidays. Although at times classes which have had a good borrowing record throughout the term may be allowed to borrow over the minor school holidays
-  Students are encouraged to use the eLibrary to borrow from at all times but particularly over the school holiday period. Log in details are provided to students.
-  If a book is lost or damaged a replacement fee will be charged. This is the cost of the item plus a processing fee of \$7. This is non-refundable, and if a lost item is subsequently found the student is given the resource to keep.

Our aim is to provide equal access to the resources of the library and to maintain a vibrant, relevant and happy place to visit.

We will always endeavour to purchase books of relevance and high quality. Please let us know if you or your child, have any requests for books.
