- Visit <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-working-children-check> and complete the online application form.
- Once you have completed the form you will be given an application number.
- Please take your email with the application number to your local RMS (Roads and Maritime Services) with Proof of Identity.
- It can take anywhere from a few days to four weeks to receive your WWCC Clearance Number and you will receive an outcome email from the RMS (please check your junk folders as the email will come from WWCNotifications@kids.nsw.gov.au)
- Once you receive your WWCC Clearance Number please email this along with your Date of Birth to phpavolunteer@tphs.nsw.edu.au
