Leadership and Outdoor Education

We prepare students for life beyond the classroom and give them skills to work as part of a team.

The School has a leadership program in the Boys' Grammar School and Girls' College: Year Prefects, Student Representative Council and other leadership opportunities are also available. All students can become school leaders after completing a two to three year Leaders Program. This program helps them develop the confidence, skills and knowledge to be a good leader.

Outdoor Education is also a critical area that helps students build leadership skills and confidence and is available to all Senior School students. The program is structured so students work together in small groups and deals directly with concepts such as leadership, inclusiveness and the value of working towards a common goal. Pittwater House also participates in The Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.





Music and the Arts

The study of music, performing arts and dance allows for the expression of emotion, imagination, the intellect and the exploration of values.

Through these pursuits, students are given the opportunity to develop both their self-confidence and skills.

We offer a wide range of opportunities including: private tuition, membership to one or more ensembles and performance at community and school events. A variety of bands, ensembles and performance groups means there is something for everyone.

In addition to curriculum subjects to HSC level, performing arts and dance are offered to Senior School students as a co-curricular option to further develop their performance skills. We have a variety of events in which Senior School students can get involved, including the musical production, performing arts festivals and the Carol Night. Senior students also have the opportunity to participate in Stage 4 Eisteddfod Dance.

Global Opportunities

Students in Years 8, 9 and 10 can also opt to participate in the World Challenge Program (students travel when they are in Years 9 or 10).

The School also offers students the opportunity to travel overseas for unique and exciting programs such as Space Camp, French Immersion and Science Investigation.

Beyond the Classroom

Sports

Sport plays a significant role in the life of Pittwater House students and as such we offer a variety of co-curricular sporting activities and competitive sporting opportunities throughout the year. With experienced coaches on hand, our students' skills are cultivated to allow them to reach their full potential.

Unlike many other schools Pittwater House also has the benefit of many 'on-campus facilities' such as a swimming pool, large multi-purpose playing field, an indoor sports complex and tennis, basketball and netball courts.



Cadets

Pittwater House has a responsibility to contribute to the community in which it is based. Part of this involves being thoughtful, responsible individuals in the local area. It also includes involvement in a wide variety of community service programs.

Pittwater House has a long tradition with its voluntary Army Cadet Unit. Our Unit allows Senior School students (from Year 8) to become involved in community service activities such as Anzac Day Services. However, it also goes beyond local support and focuses on leadership and team building skills from an early age.

Competitions

Students should be able to stretch their skills and abilities through healthy competition and cultivate their interests through clubs. As such, Pittwater House offers involvement in a variety of clubs and academic competitions. A summary of the types of clubs and competitions on offer is listed on the back of this brochure.
